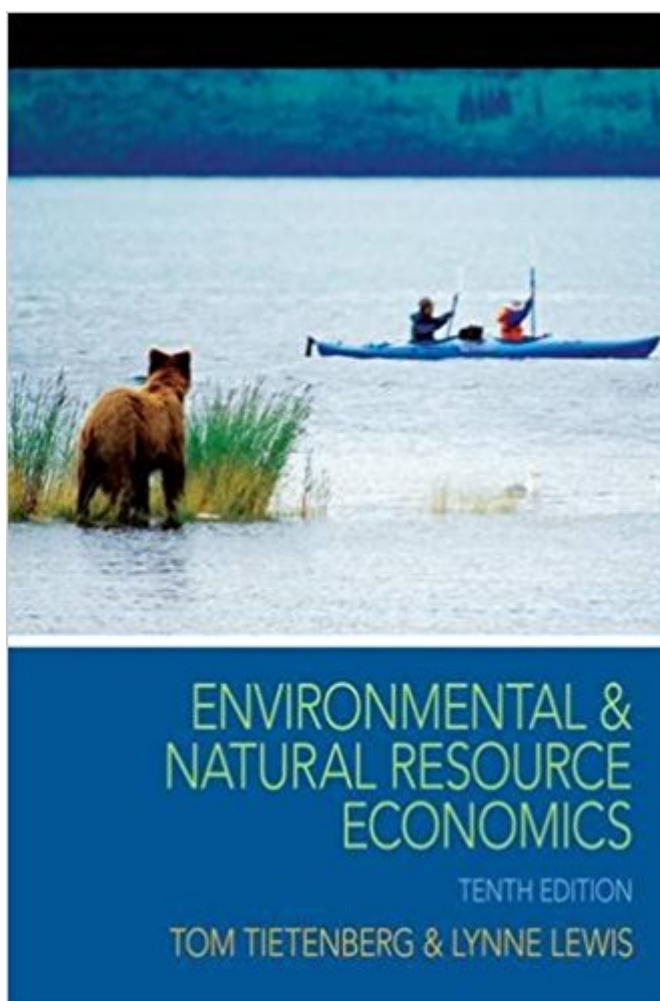

As for mathematical examples, it simply shoots numbers at you without clear explanation. I would not recommend this book for class.

I'm only a week into the course for which I'm using this (two chapters), but so far I have found this book very interesting and well written. This book provides a great framework for thinking about environmental issues which will be interesting to economics students (my background), helpful for students of environmental issues, and informative for people who fall into neither category.

I probably just didn't understand the material and that's why I don't like this textbook. I am smart and when I read something I usually understand it. The reading was great, but the practical questions and discussion questions were just not related to the reading. There were no examples of any kind of problem solving and the graphs were just not helpful at all. This is probably a book for an experienced economist.
