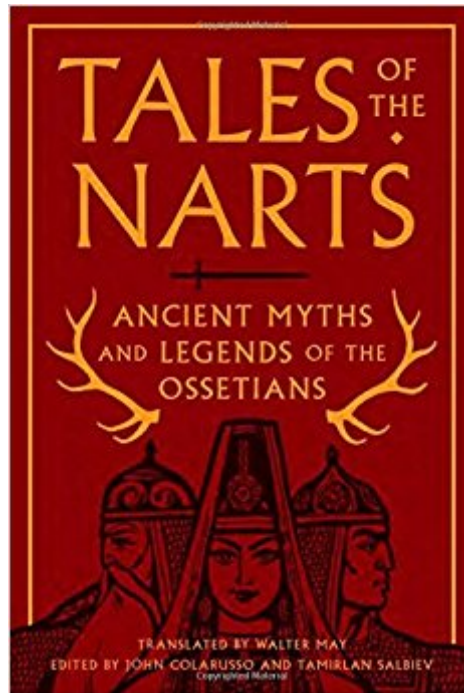




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Tales Of The Narts: Ancient Myths And Legends Of The Ossetians
