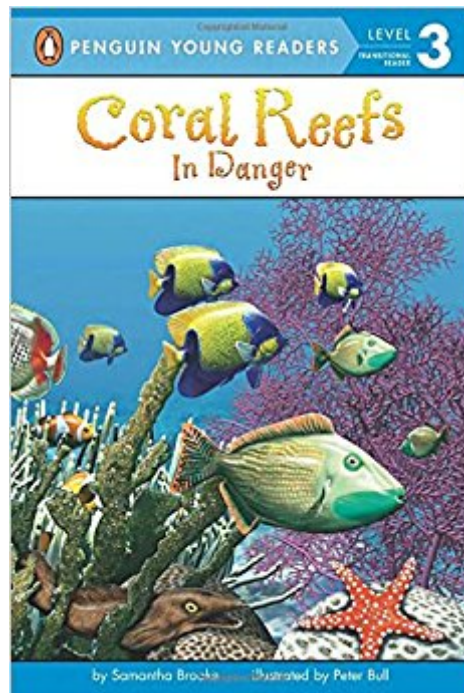




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Coral Reefs: In Danger (Penguin Young Readers, Level 3)
