The one-star reviews should just be ignored, but the five-star ones, in my opinion, overstate the case. What is really missing is a decisive editor: the book takes too long to explain things, and sometimes goes in circles, and not in a way that suggests pedagogical intent. As the book seeks to

offer an introduction to project management, not just Microsoft Project, that "soft" material, too, takes up space, and actually distracts and detracts from its coverage of Microsoft Project. Contrast to "Managing Projects with Microsoft Office Project 2007" by Ballew, Reynolds and (surprise!) Biafore, which keeps the "soft stuff" in check, and manages to effectively explain Microsoft Project - alas, an older edition of it. I would not recommend "Microsoft Project 2013: The Missing Manual" to Microsoft Project novices, and point them instead to "Microsoft Project 2013 Step by Step" by Chatfield and Johnson.

I purchased for an online class in tech project management that I am taking. Very easy to read and follow, makes using Project 2013 a breeze! The author does a great job of translating a boring PM software manual into an enjoyable read. Would recommend for anyone looking to master Project 2013.

Microsoft Project is an application designed to assist with the documentation and management of projects.
