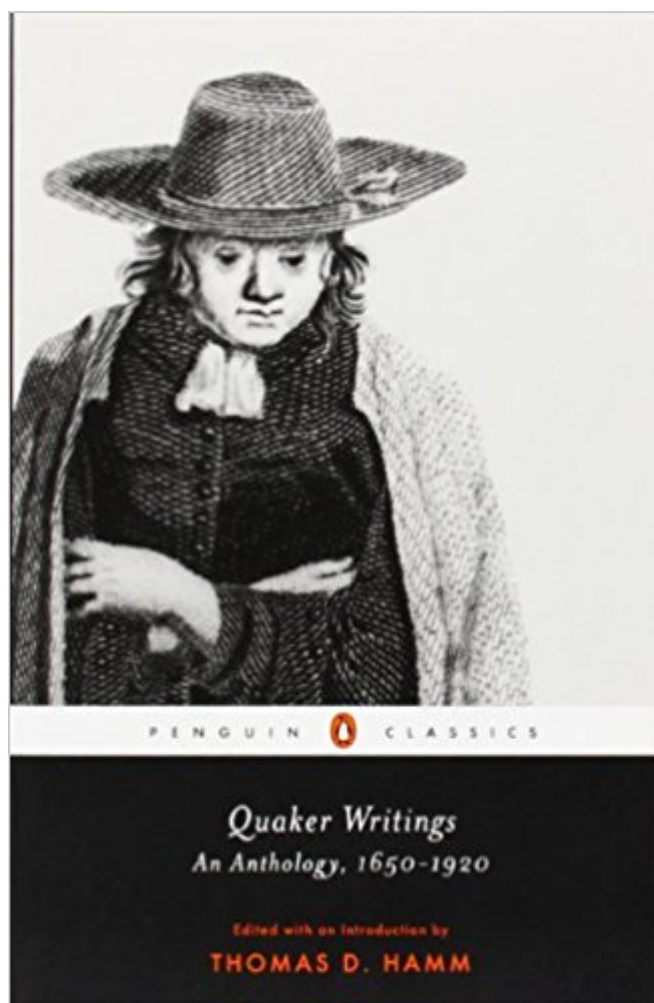


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Quaker Writings: An Anthology, 1650-1920 (Penguin Classics)
