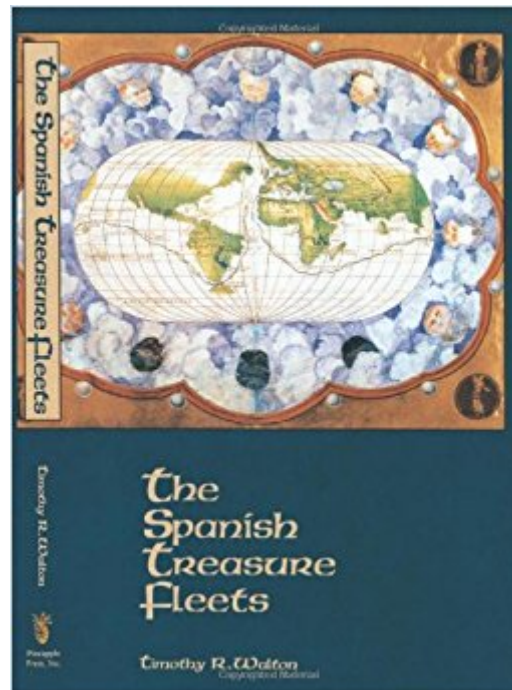

Storms and deadly reefs claimed countless other ships. By the early 1700s Spain had lost its monopoly on world trade and other countries were laying claim to colonies in the New World. The pieces of eight survived to become the model of the American silver dollar. Tales of fabulous Spanish treasure fleets kept memories alive. After World War II divers using new technology began finding not only large amounts of silver and gold but also valuable information about the history of Europe's influence on the world. The mysteries of treasure known to exist but not yet discovered continue to fascinate to this day.

An excellent reference. Very well written and easy to read. My only nit-pick is that the author refers to the 8 reales coin as a peso throughout the book. As a collector of 8 reales coins I found that to be a minor annoyance but most likely few others would care. The publisher could have done a better job - most of the photos were poorly printed and almost illegible, although it was possible to Google the images from the titles and/or descriptions and see them clearly. A color version of the book, perhaps hardbound, would be much better. Overall an excellent book and worth reading.

I found this work very informative and it kept my attention throughout. I am a collector of colonial Spanish coinage and it was nice to read more of in depth study into the history of its exchange. It helped me connect with the history of the coins in my possession. There are lots of facts and numbers so prepare for that. But nonetheless it's not hard to follow.

Tim Watson's *The Spanish Treasure Fleets* is one of the most entertaining, well-researched, and fun-to-read books I have read in ages. His coverage of first the rise and then the inevitable decline of the Spanish Empire among the untold millions of dollars in gold & silver is an incredible tale of not only greed, rape and torture of native peoples but also a story of almost unfathomable ignorance, stupidity, and incompetence of the Spanish government. His portrayal of the English & Dutch "pirates" who were constantly harassing the fleets unfolds like a true buccaneer story. And his

weaving of the way the Spanish Pillar Dollars became the first true world currency amid the crumbling infrastructure of its namesake makes one reflect on our own future. I would recommend this book to anyone who enjoys history and regard it as a must read for all numismatists.
