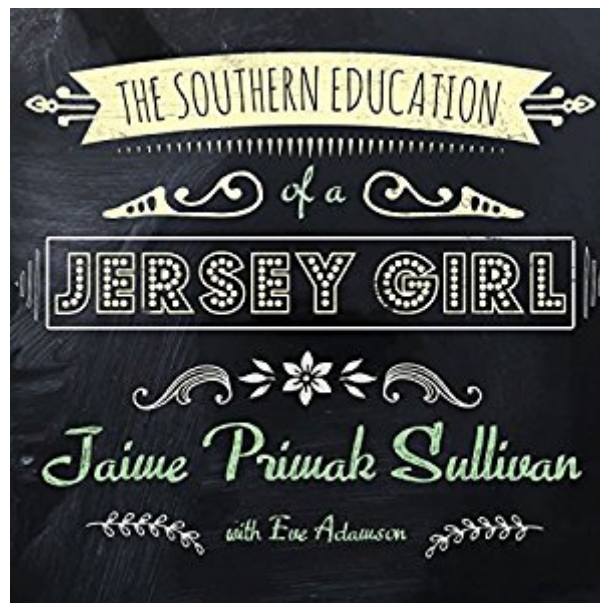




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The Southern Education Of A Jersey Girl: Adventures In Life And Love In The Heart Of Dixie
