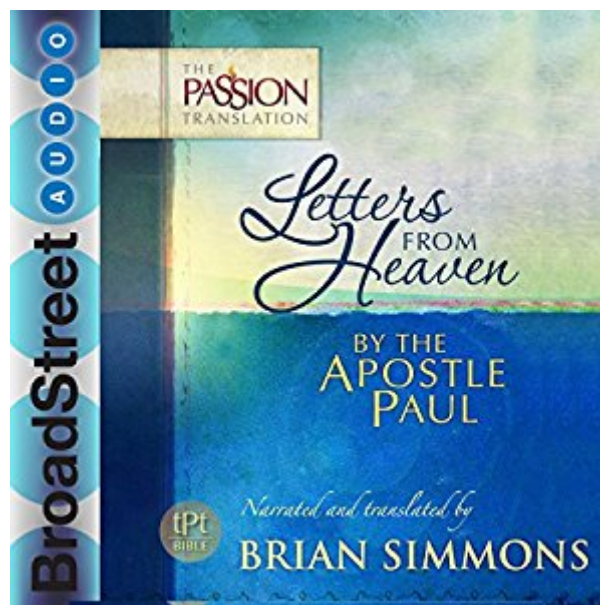




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# Letters From Heaven By The Apostle Paul: Galatians, Ephesians, Phillippians, Colossians, I & II Timothy

It could also justifiably be called a Revelation Translation. This book is a collection of six of the Pauline Epistles, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, and first and second Timothy. It is difficult to find the words to express how important this work is. During the last week before the Crucifixion of Jesus, there were some Greeks visiting Jerusalem who came to Philip with a request, sir they asked, we would like to see Jesus.
